



Where Have All The Gymnasts Gone - An Update

"Where have all the gymnasts gone" was the title of an article that appeared in JOPHER in 1985. In 1991 a response to the article appeared in the March issue of the Journal. The intent of this short article is to review some milestones and update Journal readers as to what has happened to college club gymnastics during the last 15 years.

As the result of a 1988 survey a national organization of college clubs the NACGC was formed. Its first championships were held in 1989. The meet attracted three Midwest men's clubs. However, with the support of the International Gymnast magazine the following year seven university clubs took part in the meet. This national coverage resulted in a response from the National Association of College Gymnastic Coaches. The college club association became the NAIGC.

A women's division was added in 1991. The first women's nationals was hosted by Miami University of Ohio with guidelines similar to the men. The nationals, like most NAIGC invitational meets, became co-ed in 1996. The 1999 nationals held at the Naval Academy reached a major milestone. This meet was the last time the NAIGC nationals were able to introduce all participating clubs on the floor at one time and run in one day.

The following year Indiana University's club added an award banquet to the proceedings. This has proven to be very popular, but expensive for students. Most clubs are self-supporting and must raise their own money.

At the University of Syracuse in 2001, the women's preliminary competition was divided into two sessions. Students were not happy with the results or length of the meet. The 2003 meet hosted by a group of Texas clubs marked the first time the championships were held at an off campus location. The prelims of the men's division was organized into two sessions and the women's into three. Thirty-four colleges were represented by about 350 gymnasts. An exact count is presently not available.

The major challenge most clubs face is money. In the past the USOC has supported college varsity gymnastic programs with grants. Unfortunately, the NAIGC has not been able to qualify for such aid without the support of the national governing body for gymnastics in this country.

Fortunately, the NAIGC have been supported by private club owners and some college coaches. When the club at Notre Dame lost the use of the gymnastics area at St Mary's College, a private club in the area permitted them to use their facility in the evening after regular club hours. The University of Buffalo is able to supplement their practice time on campus by the support of a private club not too far from campus. A number of clubs have never practiced on their campus.

The second major challenge for clubs is finding judges for meets. Clubs have resorted to meets with "celebrity" judges who knew nothing of gymnastics, bring your own judge, if you are not competing on and event you are judging it, and sadly only one judge per event even at the nationals.

The International Gymnast has been very supportive of the organization. The magazine has published the results of all national meets when they receive the results. The National Collegiate Gymnastics Alumni Association magazine has gone to great lengths to support the NAIGC.

In 1994 a student at Virginia Tech University established a listserv for the NAIGC that has contributed greatly to communication among clubs and its growth. A student at the University of Buffalo started a NAIGC website, but unfortunately he graduated. Currently a website (www.naigc.net) has been put together by a student at North Carolina University-Greensboro. Check the site if you have students who may be interested in forming a club at their campus or attending a university that has a gymnastics club.

The major strength of the organization is that it is primarily student run, and the major weakness of the organization is that it is primarily student run.

However, the future of the NAIGC looks very bright. Its major challenge will be keeping up with its rapid grown. Next year the nationals are returning to Eastern Michigan University. We are planning for more than three teams, and would enjoy having your university's gymnastics club participate in what will be the 16th annual championships or the 17th annual championships.

This rebirth of college gymnastics is not the result of coaches, judges, lawyers, laws, and certainly not administrators. It is the result of students who are involved for the love of the sport.
